## **CMSgt (retired) Christopher Edris**

A native of Lebanon, Pennsylvania, Chief Edris entered the Air Force in June 1975 and was assigned duty as vocalist with the Tactical Air Command Band, Langley Air Force Base, Virginia. His subsequent assignments include March AFB, California; McChord AFB, Washington; McGuire AFB, New Jersey, and Hanscom AFB, MA. Chief Edris is a professional entertainer with over 20 years of performing experience throughout the United States and overseas, and has appeared on stage with Bob Hope and Elizabeth Taylor. He retired in 2000.



## **MSgt (retired) Julia Schembre**

A native of Evansville, IN, Master Sergeant Schembre entered the USAF in June 1976 and was assigned to the Air Force Band of the West at Lackland AFB, Texas. She was subsequently stationed at Ramstein AFB, Germany; Yokota AFB, Japan, and Offutt AFB, Nebraska. During her career, she entertained such notables as Henry Kissinger and Jimmy Stewart. Master Sergeant Schembre retired in March 1999, and currently works at Oakland City University. She is an active member of Amvets Post #4, and frequently performs for veterans groups throughout Indiana. She is currently working on recordings of her original compositions.
