



PROGRAM GUIDE

In the near future, The United States Air force Band of Flight will be performing in your area. As a sponsor, you have the responsibility of providing a quality-printed program. **Please do not use mimeograph.** All of the information and materials needed to print the programs have been included with this guide, or in your sponsor packet. Advertising, per se, is not permitted on the programs. Businesses and individuals that contribute toward the cost of printing can be listed as donors, and their valuable assistance can be acknowledged from the stage.

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

1. **Paper:** The paper may be of any quality and color the sponsor chooses. Any color and number of inks may be used.
2. **Paper Size:** The original paper size should be standard 8 1/2" x 11" or any size which can be folded into a standard size program (5 1/2" x 8 1/2").
3. **Cover:** The cover should contain the following information:

THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE BAND OF FLIGHT
NIGHT FLIGHT JAZZ ENSEMBLE
Date (day, date, month, and year)
Time, location
Sponsor identification

The layout and design of the cover page are up to the sponsor. Examples of past programs have been provided, but you need not feel limited to these formats. Creativity is encouraged and appreciated!

4. **Additional Material:** Additional pages should contain the following information:
 - ◆ Band personnel list
 - ◆ Program selections
 - ◆ Information from Night Flight Fact Sheet and Band of Flight History Sheet
 - ◆ Comments address and Band web page address (bottom of page 2)
5. **Optional Material:** The following is optional, but highly desirable if space permits:
 - ◆ Band photo
 - ◆ Bandleader's biography (whole or part) and photo
 - ◆ Vocalist (s) biography (whole or Part) and photo
 - ◆ Featured soloist(s) biography (whole or part) and photo

The information may be arranged in any order, using any layout and design you wish. A suggested look to the back of the program is on page two of this guide.
